



# Offshore Wind Conference 2026

Ireland's offshore wind targets are to scale from 5 – 37 GW between 2030 – 2050. To achieve this Ireland has delivered an Offshore Wind Industrial Strategy and Future Framework Policy, focusing on long term delivery of offshore wind. 5 projects (Phase One) are currently in the planning system. Ireland's second offshore auction (ORESS Tonn Nua) will be taking place later in 2025 to develop a 900 MW project in one of four sites which has been identified for future offshore wind development off Ireland's south coast. In addition, the Irish Government has commenced the development of a National Designated Maritime Area Plan, which will identify additional sites right around the coastline of Ireland to expand and grow our offshore wind industry over the coming decade and beyond.

The more than 500 delegates who will attend our Offshore Wind Conference are the people deciding how we plan, connect and trade electricity from offshore wind energy. Putting your brand front and centre at this event drives home the message that when we're talking about our 'offshore revolution', we are talking about you.
