CLIMATE **ACTION PLAN** 2019

Irish ORE Pipeline Projects





- Total > 9.5 GW. Target 3.5 GW
- Total Fixed 8 GW
- Total East Coast Fixed 6.6 GW
- Legacy ~ 2 GW
- 10 year indicative programme

To meet the required level of emissions reduction, by 2030 we will:

- Reduce CO₂ eq. emissions from the sector by 50-55% relative to 2030 NDP projections
- Deliver an early and complete phase-out of coal- and peat-fired electricity generation
- Increase electricity generated from renewable sources to 70%, indicatively comprised
 of:*
 - o at least 3.5 GW of offshore renewable energy
 - o up to 1.5 GW of grid-scale solar energy
 - o up to 8.2 GW total of increased onshore wind capacity
- Meet 15% of electricity demand by renewable sources contracted under Corporate PPAs

['The exact level of offshore wind, onshore wind, solar and other renewable technology will be determined by a new system of competitive auctions where the lowest cost technology will be determined, see box below.]
