TIMFLINE

3 rd August 2022	Call for abstracts closes at 5pm. Please use the template provided.
Early-August 2022	Our team will evaluate the abstracts and shortlist participants.
Mid-August 2022	Applicants will be informed if their research has been selected to be showcased at the Wind Energy Ireland Offshore Conference.
14 th September 2022	Attendees will be required to submit their final presentations to WEI. We may request slight adaptations if necessary.
21st & 22nd September 2022	Wind Energy Ireland Offshore Conference taking place.

FURTHER INFORMATION

- 1. Research Abstracts are invited from undergraduate and masters level students (i.e., those who have recently completed their final year/masters' projects or are about to enter final year).
- 2. Applications should be emailed in PDF format to research@windenergyireland.com no later than 5pm on Wednesday 3rd August 2022. **Please use the Abstracts Template provided.**
- 3. An expert panel will evaluate abstracts and establish which ones are accepted for presentation at the event. Abstracts will be scored on novelty, impact, and communication.
- 4. Successful applicants will be notified in mid-August and invited to prepare a 3-minute pitch of their project, to be presented at the conference.
- 5. Participants will receive full access to the conference, taking place in UCD, Dublin on 21st and 22nd September 2022. Note: Travel and accommodation costs are not included.
- 6. A total of 8 short pitches will take place throughout the conference, on the main stage. Full details on the format, criteria etc. for participants will be communicated in August.
- 7. A winning pitch will be selected by our judges, with a prize presented to the winning entry.
- 8. A limited number of complimentary single day passes for the conference will also be offered to students. A raffle will take place in August (which will include all applicants inc. those not selected to make a pitch) to determine the lucky recipients of these passes!
- 9. The initiative will provide an unprecedented opportunity for students to engage with key industry stakeholders and attendees. There may even be a job or two on offer if you ask!
