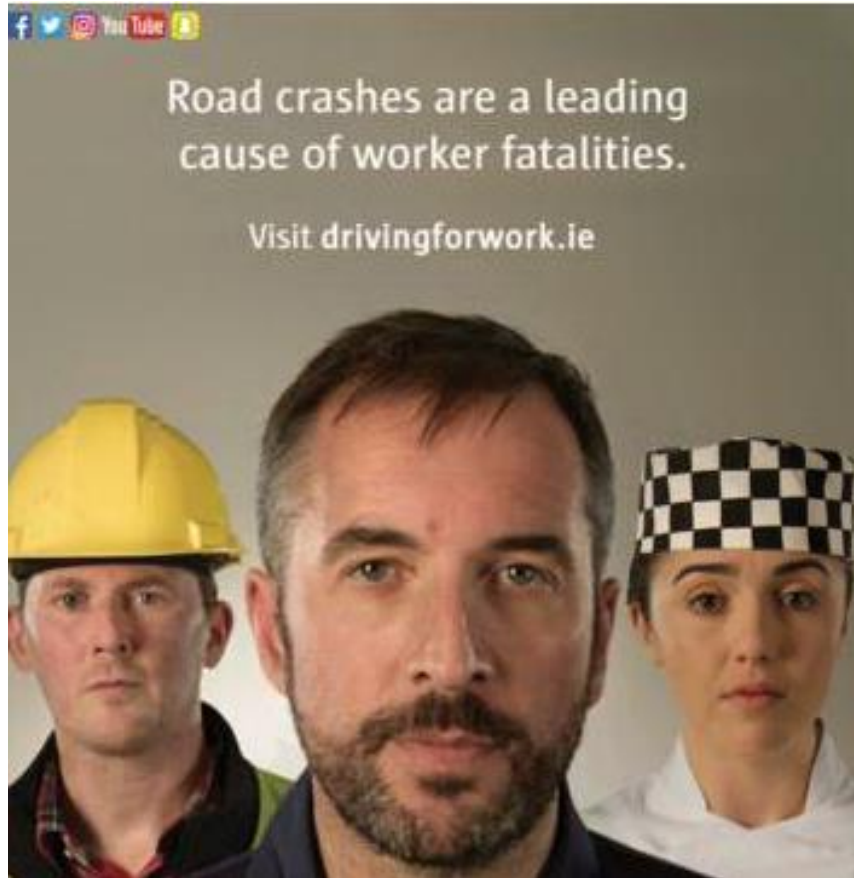

We can't ignore the facts.....do you know?



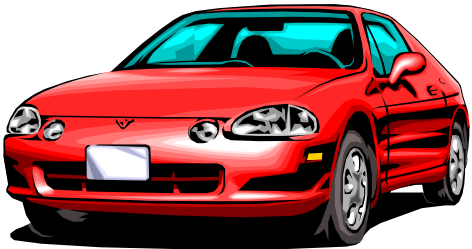
Over **25,600 lives lost** on the road in the EU in 2016.

Driving is one of our highest risk areas in ESB

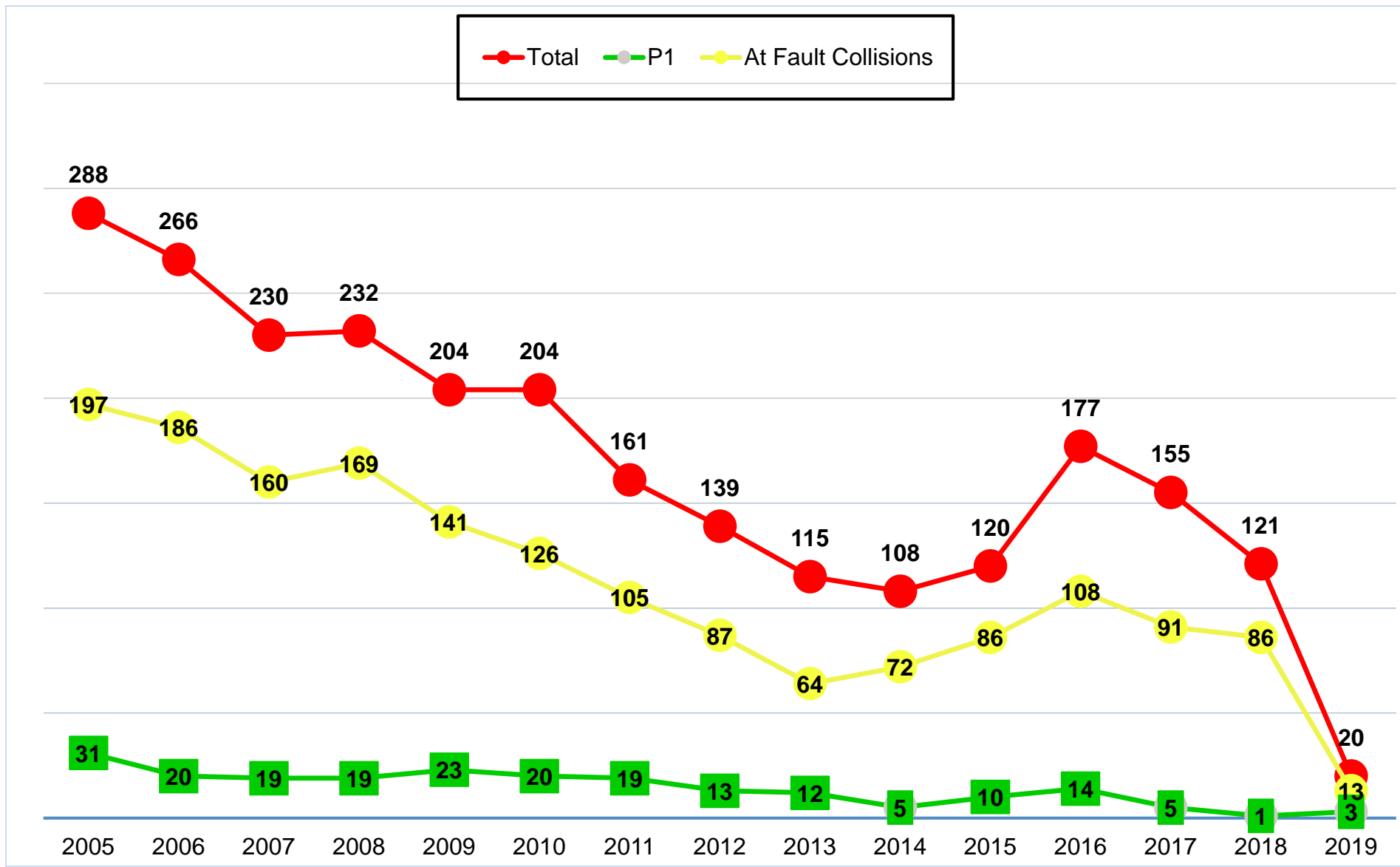


2000 commercial (yellow) fleet vehicles
32 million km per annum



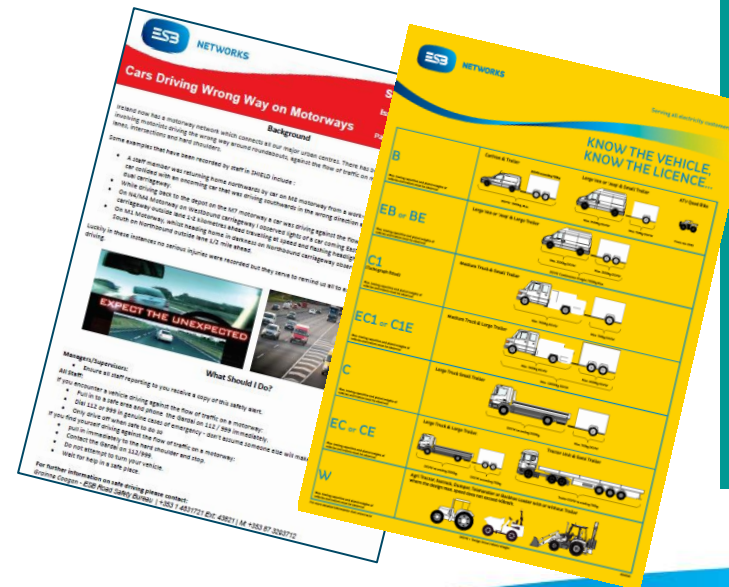
Grey Fleet - 2000+ driving privately owned cars on ESB business

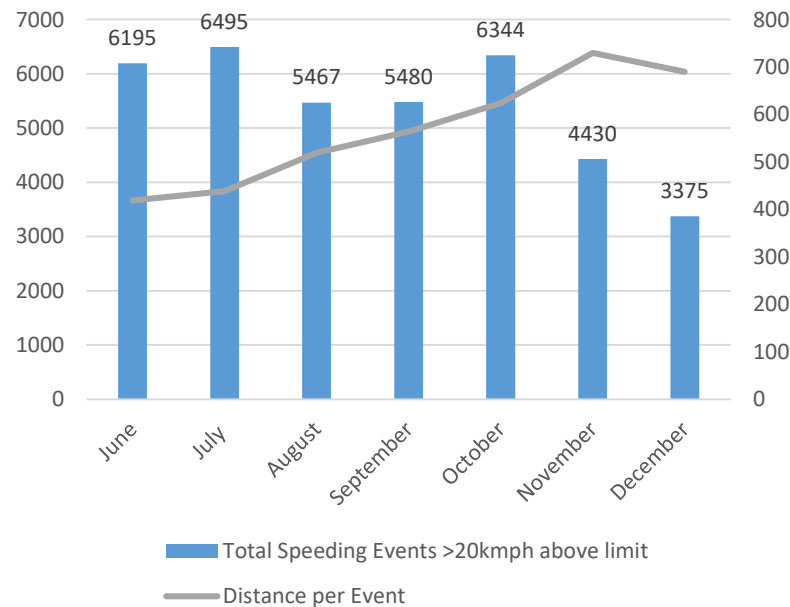
Speeding Conversation Trend

Management of high-risk road users FMS

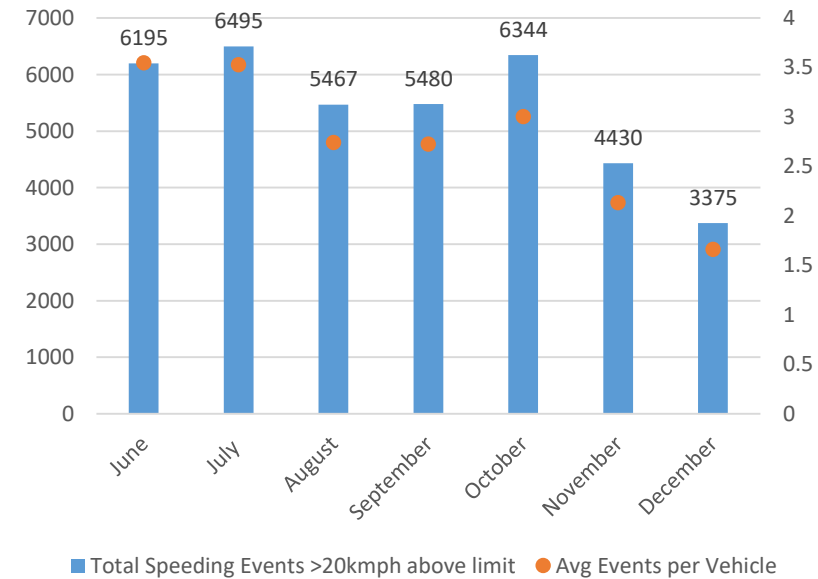
Driver reports for all speeding >20 above posted speed limit.
